Hello Everyone,

I would like to thank everyone who came out to the January meeting at the field. We had a great turnout. For the immediate future, meetings will be held at the field on a Saturday morning. The next meeting will be February 20th at 9am. Model of the month will also be resuming next month. Not only will we be selecting model of the month, members are encouraged to share any new projects they are working on.

Our next virtual board meeting will be February 3rd. The main theme of this meeting will be picking dates for upcoming events such as the Heli-Fun-Fly, Jet and Warbird Events. Most of our major events will begin closer to summer when the current health crisis is projected to be less of an issue. The next scheduled event will be the Combat Trifecta. It will take place Sunday, February 7th from 9-10am. If you would like to become an Event Coordinator check out the AMA website for the requirements. We currently only have four. You can help with organizing events, and it does have other advantages! Members can contact me with any questions.

Field maintenance: the gravel on the entry road has held up well during the most recent rains. The new DG dirt placed at the Heli field, pit area has also been a great improvement! We will be starting some more weed abatement to counter the rains we have been getting. Contact me if you can help with hand spraying and tractor spraying. Joe Villarreal, Hal Meeker and Steve Kerrin are working on setting up the new sensor on the gate. When we replaced the stolen gear, the manufacturer of the gate upgraded and changed the system we previously had installed. When entering or exiting the field, as soon as the gate opens, pass through in a timely manner. Two cars can safely get through before the timer will close the gate.

Housekeeping: Please have your club IDs displayed when you are at the field. This is especially helpful on the weekends when we have guests, visitors and travelers at the field. Please renew/register with the FAA as an operator of model aircraft and display the your registration number somewhere on the outside of all models. You must also have your required identification information on, or in, your models listing your AMA number, Name and phone number.

Don Davis and Chris Avellino have pretty much wrapped up putting together our new training syllabus and instructor guidelines. We will be ready ahead of the scheduled opening of training in March. If you have an interest in helping out with Monday evening (5pm- dusk) training as an instructor or assisting in the operation, contact Don Davis.

Club meetings at the field will of course be dependent on the weather. Between now and May, we may have to reschedule due to weather. We will advise members in an email blast if a meeting will be rescheduled. Bring a lawn chair to help with social distancing. All are encouraged to participate in Model of the Month and if you have a current project, we would love to see it!

David Storey has generously donated several panes to the club. All members who show up to the next meeting will receive a raffle ticket and a plane will be given away. I look forward to seeing everyone who can make it out!

In Memory of Darrell Albert

It is with a heavy heart that I must inform you of the passing of Darrell Albert. Darrell passed away at 2 AM on New Year's Day, his body finally shutting down after years of battling diabetes and congestive heart failure.

His son, Darrin, reported that he had been in hospital through Christmas and was in a nursing home until Wednesday, when he wanted to go home. He wanted to be part of the upcoming Trifecta, but the "Man Above" had other plans for him.

Darrell embodied the generous spirit of our club. He was truly "Mr. Combat" and helped promote the original nitro combat competitions, posted scores on the national scoreboard and, in later years, was the Trifecta scorekeeper and awards distributor.

Darrell was a Vietnam Veteran.

His son Darren reported, "He had full renal failure due to diabetes and congestive heart failure. All the times in hospital and dialysis over the last 5 years and he never once complained or said, "Poor me."

For his service to the club, Darrell was a Life Member.

Darrell will be greatly missed.

Our wishes go out to Doug, Keith, Darrin and all the rest of the Albert family.












