

WORLD FAMOUS NORTH BLIMP HANGAR AT TUSTIN BURNED DOWN ON 11/7/23! A number of us flew rubber powered planes in the great hangar.

A Memorial Tribute to the North Tustin Hangar


Two gargantuan blimp hangars were quickly constructed in 1942 to house 12 blimps which patrolled the West Coast to seek out enemy submarines from Japan. The hangars are 1,000 feet long, 300 feet wide and 17 stories or 170 feet high. They are owned by the U.S. Navy and have been vacant for 20 years. They were built mainly from Oregon pine. In 1993 the hangars earned the distinction of "Historic Civil Engineering Landmarks" of the 20th century. They are the largest wood structures of their kind as free-standing buildings.

The hangar sustained wind damage in 2013, but was stabilized; it remained closed. If you are interested in the history of these remarkable hangars, The City of Tustin and County of Orange produced a book titled, "The Tustin Hangars" Titans of History. An historical account of the MCAS Tustin Hangars.

















Gary Marquardt sometimes feels a stabbing pain. Steve Gebler took this photo and he may be on to diagnosing the pain. What do ya think?




