- **Vic's Event Planning Document** Suggestions made to improve promotion section: Notify local clubs of upcoming event as well as use of "NextDoor".
- Vic's Event Planning Document BOD discussed whether to make this format a mandatory requirement for future event organizers or to strongly recommend it as a good tool. BOD decided to suggest it as a very useful tool, and to outline the requirements for the Event Organizers, especially financial accountability.
- **Event Planning** Don volunteered to write up a draft of the requirements for those organizing and running an event.
- **Payment Processing for Club Events** Don & Doug to form committee to investigate and plan the implementation of payment processing solutions for club events (Square, Paypal, Zelle)

- **Flying above 400'** The AMA requires a form be filled out to allow us to fly above 400'. George Daw is pursuing this.

- **Western Days event at Valley Center** Doug is leading the club's involvement in this event on May 31st & June 1st.
- **Mowing weeds** BOD authorized Charles to hire someone for \$15/hr to use the club's tractor to mow the area for weeds.


















Bobby Johannes brought this Focke-Wulf FW-190 for Model-of-the-Month.



Club treasurer Doug Abel gave his monthly report to the club.








