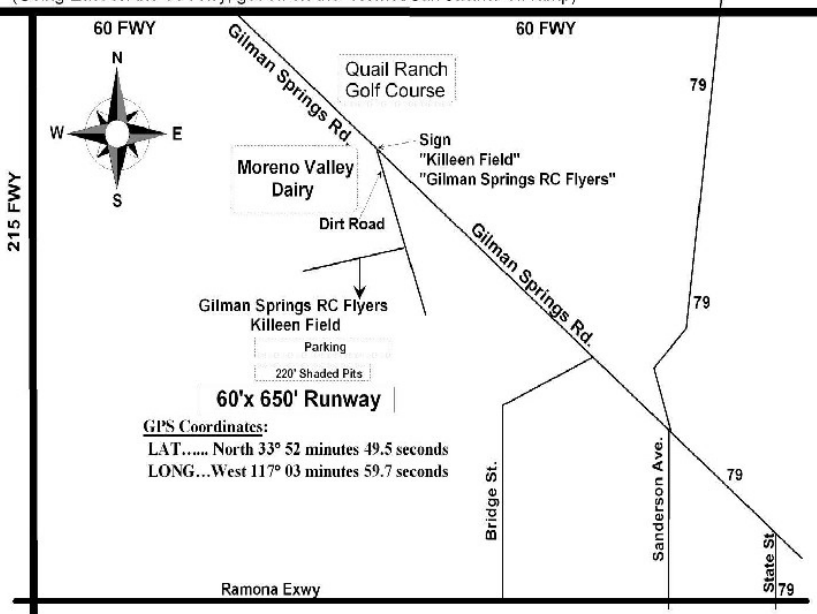

**General Membership Meeting - March 15th

Called to order:

The meeting was called to order at 7:15 pm by the Club President.

Motion made:

A motion was made and seconded to waive reading the previous meetings minutes and accept them into record as published in the Transmitter.

Treasurer's report:

Varley gave the Treasurer's report. He stated, "the Club's bank balance is now \$28,231.18". "This covers from February 1st through March 15th". The Club has received a \$800 donation from Hobby People. A motion was made and seconded to accept the Treasurer's report.

Old business:

Bill reminded the Members of our ongoing effort to reduce noise at the field. He also described a phone call he received from Betty Lou, one of the residents across the freeway. She indicated that at times noise levels were still too high in her opinion. Bill suggested we try and fly gas powered aircraft more to the east end of the field after take off. All Club members should remain aware of noise concerns at all times while flying.

The Fallbrook Air Show is coming up Sunday, April 15th. Aircraft setup will be from 7:30 until 9:45 in the morning. From 10:00 until 3:00 the runway will be closed to full size aircraft. During this time RC pilots have the chance to demonstrate their flying skills to the public. Glenn Pohly is the event Chairman and is circulating a sign up sheet for those who plan on attending the show.

Bill Hill hosted a Delta Dart build with the Cadets of CAP Squadron 714 a couple of weeks ago. Our Club will be hosting the Cadets at Johnson Field on May 12th to introduce them to RC flying.

New business:

Ron Ramos is in charge of Vector Control for San Diego County. He was given access to Johnson Field to test for Hantavirus. This virus is carried by mice and transmitted through their urine and feces. Container #2 at the field has had a mouse problem in the past. Bill suggested that anyone entering the container should wait a few minutes for it to air out before going inside as a precaution.

Bill has been in contact with Lynn Murphy who is the director for the Young Adventurer's Club in Escondido. We will be hosting the Club at our field in July. A tentative date will be either the 14th or 21st of the month.

Some dates to note are:

Temecula Valley Flyers is having a Fun-Fly and 3D Circus on Saturday, April 14th.

Gillman Springs RC Flyers will hold their annual “Dawn Patrol” on Saturday, April 21st.

Flight training:

Lead Instructor, Dennis Newbeck, reported that “the first Monday night training session went well“. Four training airplanes have been purchased from Hobby Town for the instructors to use. About 6 or 7 trainees showed up and took part in the activities.

Pictorial presentation:

Following the break, Bill Hill, gave a slide show depicting the building process of his Newport 11. The series of photos taken throughout his build, documented the journey from a box of balsa wood to a beautiful scale flying model of the famous WW1 fighter. Thanks, Bill.

A Tribute to Jack Dedrick:

Joe Buko provided the Membership with a slide pictorial in remembrance of Jack Dedrick. Jack recently passed away after a battle with pneumonia. Jack’s warm smile will be missed at the field, as will his vast knowledge of flying models that he often shared with other members.

Door prize:

The meeting ended with the \$50 door prize drawing. Congratulations go to Larry Hufford !

Document review:

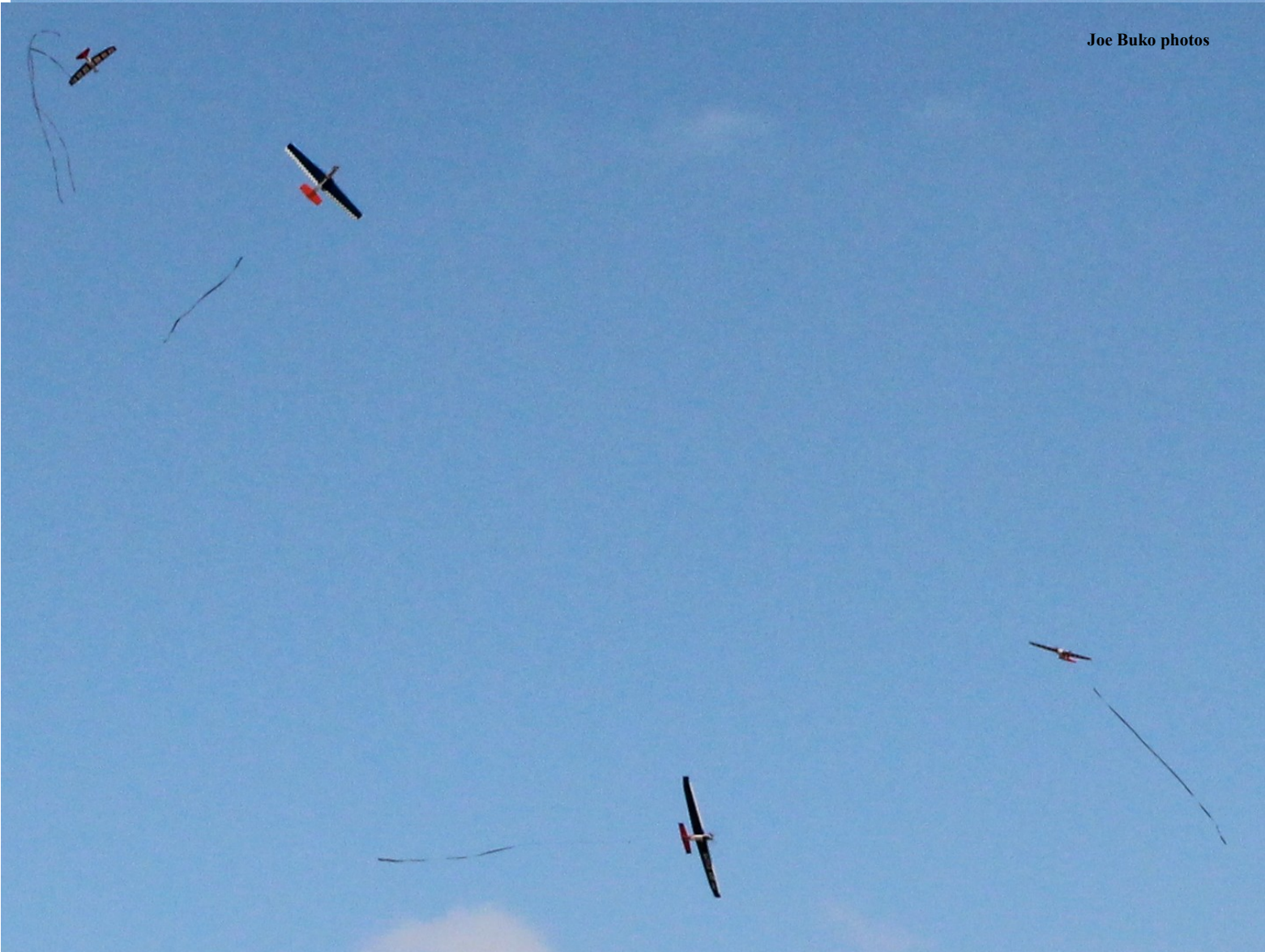

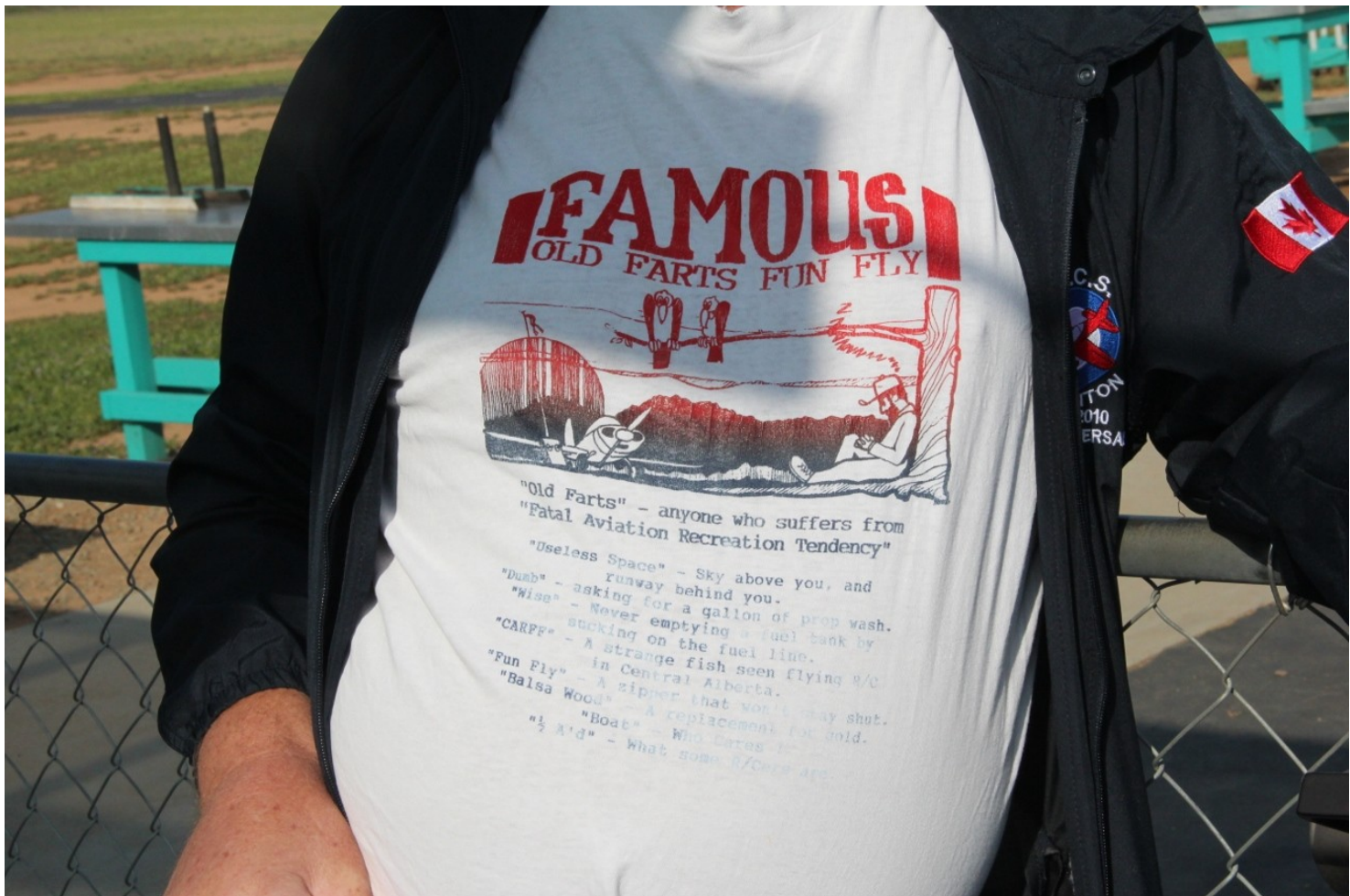
