Palomar Radio Control Flyers Overnight Camping Privileges

Camping Regulations

Overnight camping may be allowed under the following conditions:

You must be an active member with Palomar Radio Control Flyers. Guests may camp at the field but must be accompanied at all times by an active member.

It is the campers' responsibility to keep the main gate locked after the last pilot has completed his/her flying for the day.

Any club member may use the facilities to camp for a single overnight period at any time without permission.

During club sanctioned events, members or registered guests may stay one night before the event, through the event, and for one night after the event without permission.

No member is allowed to camp out at the field for more than 5 nights in any given 30 day period.

With permission from the club President or Vice President, extended stays may be granted, but for no more than three consecutive nights. Extended stays beyond three nights may be requested and granted at the discretion of the club President or Vice President.

All camping must be self contained. No water or electricity will be provided.

If the camper uses a generator, it must contain the proper spark arresting equipment, and must not produce excessive noise during operation. Please be considerate of the other campers and residential neighbors in the vicinity with regard to operation of generators at night. Quiet hours are between 9 P.M. and 7 A.M. daily.

No dumping of any liquids (including gray water or black water systems) are allowed.

All trash must be disposed of in the proper containers or be removed when leaving the field.

Open wood burning fires are not permitted. Propane fire pits are permitted.

No alcoholic beverages are allowed.

In the event of an emergency, contact 911 and one of the club officers immediately.
